Dear Parents or Guardians,

Enclosed you will find information regarding home schooling in Oregon, including a Notification of Intent to Home School form, a brochure covering general home school information, Oregon Guidelines for Home Schooling, Commonly Asked Questions and Answers, Testing Information, Qualified Testers, and Resources and Support Groups.

If you live in Clackamas County and make the decision to home school your child, Oregon Administrative Rule 581-21-026 requires you to:

1. Provide Clackamas Education Service District (ESD) with a one-time written notification of your intent to home school *within ten calendar days before the start of school* for your local district, or *within ten calendar days of withdrawing your child from school*. A Notification of Intent to Home School form is enclosed to assist in meeting this requirement. Please send the notification to:

2. Test your child by August 15 following grades 3, 5, 8 and 10.

3. Provide test results to Milt Dennison, Superintendent of Clackamas ESD, at the above address, within two week after testing takes place.
